

Leather upholstery product care instruction

Maintenance:

- Leather upholstery needs to be cleaned and conditioned regularly to avoid drying out and cracking.
- To minimize fading, avoid exposing your furniture to direct sunlight or heat.
- Dusting and vacuuming your furniture weekly is recommended.
- Wipe away any spills immediately with a soft damp cloth followed by a clean dry cloth.
- It is common for leather to stretch with use and for foam & padding to soften over time.
- For water rings and spots; remove wet objects on furniture immediately and blot surface dry. Given time, the water will evaporate and the rings will disappear.

Care instruction:

- Do not place sharp objects on leather such as toys, buckles, studs, etc.
- Avoid sitting on the arms of your furniture or on the edges of cushions as it will cause premature wear and distortion of the padding and fabric.
- Avoid direct sunlight or excessive heat as it will result in the fading of colors and the eventual disintegration of the leather.
- Do not use chemical detergents to clean, water only.
